

Unaffiliated Dressage Summer League – Rules & Scoring System

1. League Overview

The Unaffiliated Dressage Summer League is a season-long competition designed to encourage participation, consistency, and improvement at all levels. Riders accumulate points at each league show, with Champions and Supreme Champions crowned at the season finale.

2. Eligibility

Horse & Rider:

- Open to all horses and riders, regardless of affiliation.
- Riverside Priority Lounge membership required.
- Junior: under 18 on 1st March of the league year.
- Horses may enter multiple levels but not more than two levels apart.
- Separate leagues for Adults and Juniors

Levels Offered:

- Intro, Prelim, Novice, Elementary, Medium, Freestyle to Music.

3. League Structure

- League runs 6 shows from April to September.

Show dates are: -

Sunday 26th April

Saturday 23rd May

Saturday 20th June

Sunday 5th July

Saturday 1st August

Sunday 13th September (Championship Show)

- Rider's best 4 results count toward league totals.

4. Scoring System

Points by Percentage:

70%+ = 12 pts

68-69.99% = 11 pts

66–67.99% = 10 pts

64–65.99% = 9 pts

62–63.99% = 8 pts

60–61.99% = 7 pts

58–59.99% = 6 pts

56–57.99% = 5 pts

Below 56% = 4 pts (participation)

Bonus Points:

- Class win: + 1 point
- Attendance bonus (all shows): + 1 point

5. Class Rules

Tack & Turnout:

- This competition is run under British Dressage Rules.
- Full competition attire is expected.

Conduct:

- Respectful behavior required.

Welfare:

- Horses must be fit to compete.

6. League Finals

Champions – Winner of each level, points league only, includes scores from the Championship show. (Both Adult and Juniors)

Supreme Champions – Championship show for the top 10 riders for each level. Highest placed Riverside Priority Lounge member in each class, crowned Supreme Champion. (Adults and juniors combine)

7. Tie-Break Rules

1. Highest single score.
2. Most 70%+ scores.
3. Final show result.
4. Equal placing if still tied.

8. Entry & Administration

- All entries must be made via the website before close of entries.
- Membership number must be supplied upon booking.
